Our records show that you are **NOT** registered to vote.
If you want to vote, **YOU MUST REGISTER.**

You are eligible to vote in the **November 8, 2016 General Election** if you:

- Are a United States citizen
- Are a resident of the District of Columbia
- Do not claim voting residence outside of the District of Columbia
- Are at least 18 years old
- Are not in jail for a crime that is a felony in the District of Columbia
- Have not been found by a court to be legally incompetent to vote
- Have resided in the District of Columbia for at least 30 days immediately prior to the election

We offer same-day registration during Early Voting and on Election Day,
but if you want to save time at the polls, register before **October 11, 2016:**
