## **Register to Vote**

Oct 31 Last day to register to vote and automatically receive a ballot by mail.

Nov 8 Last day to register in person through sameday registration.

Oct 31

Nov

All voters registered by this date will automatically receive a mail ballot. Your mail ballot must be received by Election Day.

## **Vote Early in Person**

Oct

First day to vote early in person.

Nov 8 In-person voting centers are open through Election Day.
