Last day to request an absentee ballot by mail or in person at your local clerk's office.

Your absentee ballot must be received by Election Day.

Only voters with an acceptable reason may vote by absentee ballot. These reasons include sickness, disability, absence from your city or town, or a work commitment while the polls are open.
