Register to Vote

Oct 25

Last day to register to vote and automatically receive a ballot by mail.

Nov 8

Last day to register in person through same-day registration.

Vote by Mail

Oct 25

All voters registered by this date will automatically receive a ballot by mail.

Nov 8

Mail ballots must be postmarked by Election Day.

All registered voters may vote by mail.

Vote Early in Person

Oct 22

First day to vote early in person.

Nov 4

Last day to vote early in person.

All registered voters may vote early.
